



#### Dear friends,



You've made quite the difference in 2021! I am so thankful for the impact we are making in the lives of the animals and community we serve. In 2021, we provided over 149 free educational webinars, and 219 additional educational collaterals and support materials. These materials focused on a multitude of topics from animal first aid to best practices for an animal shelter. Our team worked with local government, animal shelters and law enforcement in 2021 to positively impact the animal community in Mercer County, New Jersey. 
#### Who We Are


